DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What has been your perception of churches that you've attended? Were they churches that "played it safe" or did they take bold steps of faith?
- 2. Read Acts 2:38-41 What bold things did Peter say in this passage?
- 3. What keeps some Christians and churches from proclaiming a bold message against sin today?
- 4. We say that our purpose as a church is to inspire people to become wholehearted followers of Jesus. What are some ways that a "wholehearted follower" of Jesus behaves differently than someone who is not a Christian?
- 5. We say that our mission is to love God, love the church, and love the world. Can you give some practical examples of how to practice these three things?
- 6. An inspiring church has a radical passion. Look at Jesus' passion in Matthew 21:12-13. What can we learn from Jesus' dramatic response?
- 7. An inspiring church has a divine boldness. **Read Acts 4:29-31.** What was the last bold prayer you prayed to God?
- 8. An inspiring church has a risk-taking faith. **Read Hebrews 11:6 and Acts 15:25-25** Can you give an example of a time that you had to take a risky step of faith?

- 1. Read Acts 4:13. Where do you think Peter and John got their boldness from?
- 2. An inspiring church has an unshakable devotion. Read Acts 5:28-29.
- 3. What reason did the apostles give for their disobedience?
- 4. What would our churches, businesses, schools, and society look like if everyone determined to obey God rather than man?
- 5. In what area or areas of your life could you display more unshakable devotion to Christ?
- 6. The inspiring church is a selfless community. Read Acts 2:42-45; 4:32-34.
- 7. Share some examples of times when you have seen the church practice this kind of selflessness.
- 8. Why do you think the early Church was characterized by these particular habits?
- 9. What impact would this kind of selflessness and generosity have on unbelievers who witness it among Christians?
- 10. The inspiring church has a consuming focus. Read Acts 4:19-20; 5:41-42.
- 11. We can see here some glimpses of opposition to the newly formed church, have you faced opposition as a follower of Jesus? How can we prepare ourselves for this?

- 12. Do you fear repercussions for sharing the gospel? How can you change your perspective as the apostles did?
- 13. What would you say is the consuming focus of your life?
